10% of Loan Portfolio Must be in Khmer Riel by End of December 2019

On 01 December 2016, the National Bank of Cambodia ("NBC") issued a new Prakas to promote credit provision in national currency by requiring all banks and financial institutions under its supervision to have at least 10% (ten per cent) of their total loan portfolio provided in Khmer Riel. The Prakas has become effective from its date of issuance for all banks and financial institutions to start arranging the necessary to comply with the new requirement. The final deadline for full compliance by all banks and financial institutions is set to be 31 December 2019. The requirement under the Prakas also includes the need for banks and financial institutions to embed the required credit provision in Khmer Riel in their corporate policy and business strategy.

The main objective of the Prakas aims to enhance the usage of Khmer Riel in the economy as a mechanism to support the implementation of the national monetary policy by the central bank. Under the Prakas, NBC also reserves the right to further increase the required portion of credit provision in local currency based on future need.

For referencing purpose, the Prakas was issued under number B7-016-334P and dated 01 December 2016 as regards Credit Provision in National Currency of Bank and Financial Institutions.


